OF UNIVERSITAS NEGERI MALANG

BY THE GRACE OF GOD ALMIGHTY

THE RECTOR OF UNIVERSITAS NEGERI MALANG,

- considering : a. that in order to create an academic climate conducive for student learning and self-development activities it is deemed necessary to establish student code of ethics and rules;
- b. that according to the consideration referred to in letter a, and in order to implement Article 20 of the Regulation of the Minister of Research, Technology, and Higher Education Number 12 of 2018 on the Statutes of Universitas Negeri Malang, it is deemed necessary to enact the Regulation of the Rector of Universitas Negeri Malang on the Student Code of Ethics of Universitas Negeri Malang;
- in view of : 1. Law Number 12 of 2012 on Higher Education (State Gazette of the Republic of Indonesia of 2012 Number 158, Supplement to the State Gazette of the Republic of Indonesia Number 5336);
2. Government Regulation Number 37 of 2009 on Lecturers (State Gazette of the Republic of Indonesia of 2009 Number 76, Supplement to the State Gazette of the Republic of Indonesia Number 5007);
3. Government Regulation Number 4 of 2014 on Higher Education Organizing and Higher Education Institutions Management (State Gazette of the Republic of Indonesia of 2014 Number 16, Supplement to the State Gazette of the Republic of Indonesia Number 5500);
4. Regulation of the Minister of Education and Culture Number 30 of 2012 on The Organization and Work Procedure of Universitas Negeri Malang (Official Gazette of the Republic of Indonesia of 2012 on 493);

HAS DECIDED

to enact : THE REGULATION OF THE RECTOR OF UNIVERSITAS NEGERI MALANG ON THE STUDENT CODE OF ETHICS OF UNIVERSITAS NEGERI MALANG.

## CHAPTER I GENERAL PROVISIONS

### Article 1

In this Regulation of the Rector of Universitas Negeri Malang, the following definitions are applied.

1. Universitas Negeri Malang, hereinafter referred to as UM, is a state higher education institution that organizes academic education and may organize vocational education in various clusters of science and/or technology subjects as well as organize professional education.
2. Student is a learner who is registered with one of the study programs at UM.
3. Rector is the Rector of UM.
4. Student code of ethics is a guide containing norms which are binding to students individually in their performance of academic and student activities at Universitas Negeri Malang.
5. Student organization is a medium for the fostering and development of talents, interests, personalities, self-identities, and various activities under a framework of reference for the achievement of the University's vision and missions.
6. Student right is anything which based on the applicable regulations should be accepted by students over the course of their education pursuit at Universitas Negeri Malang.

7. Student obligation is anything which is binding and mandatory to students for the achievement of the goals set out in the student code of ethics.
8. Violation is any form of conduct, utterance, writing, drawing, or act which is in conflict with the applicable provisions.
9. Sanction is the penalty imposed upon a student who has violated a provision which is applicable at UM.

## Article 2

This student code of ethics aims:

- a. to provide a guide for all UM students to interacting and behaving within the campus or among the general public;
- b. to support the Vision, Missions, and Objectives of UM;
- c. to shape students into individuals who are pious, of noble characters, virtuous, and disciplined;
- d. to produce students with professionalism and excellence;
- e. to create an academic climate conducive for student learning and self-development activities;
- f. to build and develop an image of students who uphold ethical values at all times;
- g. to maintain order within the UM campus environment; and
- h. to build and develop mutual support and appreciation between members of UM society.

## CHAPTER II RIGHTS AND OBLIGATIONS

### Article 3

UM students are entitled to the following rights:

- a. to responsibly use the academic freedom in studying sciences and/or arts on the grounds of the moral norms and mannerism applicable in the academic environment;
- b. to gain education, instructions, academic services, information services, and facilities and infrastructure sufficiently;
- c. to receive a studies completion guide by responsible members of teaching staff (academic advisors and final assignment advisors);
- d. to receive academic and instructional services optimally according to their own interests, talents, passions, and abilities and to receive information services related to learning activities and outcomes;
- e. to receive protection against bullying, physical violence, psychological violence, sexual crimes, and/or other crimes;
- f. to receive assistance in settlement in a fair, prudent manner in the event of bullying, physical violence, psychological violence, sexual crimes, and/or other crimes;

- g. to receive welfare services according to the applicable provisions;
- h. to participate in student organizations; and
- i. to receive an award for an achievement.

#### Article 4

UM students have the following obligations:

- a. to abide by the regulations/provisions applicable at UM;
- b. to use a polite language and cause no harm to others in communication both directly and indirectly;
- c. to conform with and maintain order at UM campus;
- d. to uphold academic integrity which encompasses honesty, truth, fairness, and a sense of responsibility.

### CHAPTER III

#### STUDENT ETHICS OF UNIVERSITAS NEGERI MALANG

#### Article 5

The student ethics as members of society govern that students are:

- a. to occupy a place of honor since students serve as an example and role model for members of society and as a hope for the nation and state bearing the task of future development sustainability of the nation and state;
- b. to behave appropriately and responsibly in all acts and to honor the rights and presence of others, both in and outside the campus;
- c. to be able to provide an example and be a model for society upon the attainment of academic and professional achievements;
- d. to uphold and maintain honesty and academic and professional integrity and to conduct no fraudulent act in any form;
- e. to have high levels of motivation, adversity quotient, and forbearance to attain optimal achievements;
- f. to abide by and uphold all regulations applicable in and outside the campus; and
- g. to bear the mandate of being academic individuals and to meet commitments.

#### Article 6

The student ethics as members of academic society govern that students are:

- a. to believe in God Almighty according to their own religions and faiths;
- b. to uphold the principles in science, technology, art, literature, and national culture;
- c. to find and develop self-identity in order to contribute to the advancements of the alma mater, nation, and wider society; and
- d. to be responsible and be able to develop study plans for the sake of attaining optimal academic achievements.

## Article 7

The student ethics as learners govern that students are:

- a. to abide by all the regulations enacted at UM;
- b. to maintain security and harmony among members of academic society;  
and
- c. to maintain the smoothness of academic activities.

## Article 8

The student ethics toward the University govern that students are:

- a. as members of campus, to wear a neat, clean attire and behave politely according to the common norms and ethics applicable in the academic environment;
- b. to conduct activities and student programs according to the applicable provisions;
- c. to exercise the obligation to maintain the authority and good name of the University;
- d. to uphold values of fairness in interactions without discrimination on the basis of religion, race, social background, education, and economic status; and
- e. to use campus facilities for activities that are not in conflict with the provisions.

## Article 9

The student ethics toward Lecturers govern that students are:

- a. to respect all lecturers without discrimination on the basis of ethnicity, religion, race, and social status;
- b. to be polite to all lecturers in interactions in and outside UM;
- c. to participate in academic activities earnestly and responsibly;
- d. to do and complete the academic tasks assigned by lecturers for smooth studies completion wisely, honestly, and responsibly; and
- e. to avoid committing bullying, physical violence, psychological violence, sexual crimes, and/or other crimes to lecturers.

## Article 10

The student ethics toward Education Staff govern that students are:

- a. to respect all education staff;
- b. to be friendly and polite to all education staff in interactions in and outside UM; and
- c. to avoid committing bullying, physical violence, psychological violence, sexual crimes, and/or other crimes to education staff.

## Article 11

The student ethics toward fellow students govern that students are:

- a. to respect all other students without discrimination on the basis of ethnicity, religion, race, and social status;

- b. to cooperate with other students in their studies pursuit;
- c. to have a high level of solidarity and be mutually helpful to each other for purposes which are good and not in conflict with the legal norms as well as other norms prevailing in society; and
- d. to avoid committing bullying, physical violence, psychological violence, sexual crimes, and/or other crimes to fellow students.

CHAPTER IV  
SANCTIONS AND ENFORCEMENT

Article 12

- (1) Students must practice UM's student code of ethics and report any violation.
- (2) Violations of the code of ethics are subject to academic and non-academic sanctions according to the applicable regulations.

CHAPTER V  
CONCLUSION

Article 13

This Rector Regulation comes to effect on the date of enactment.
